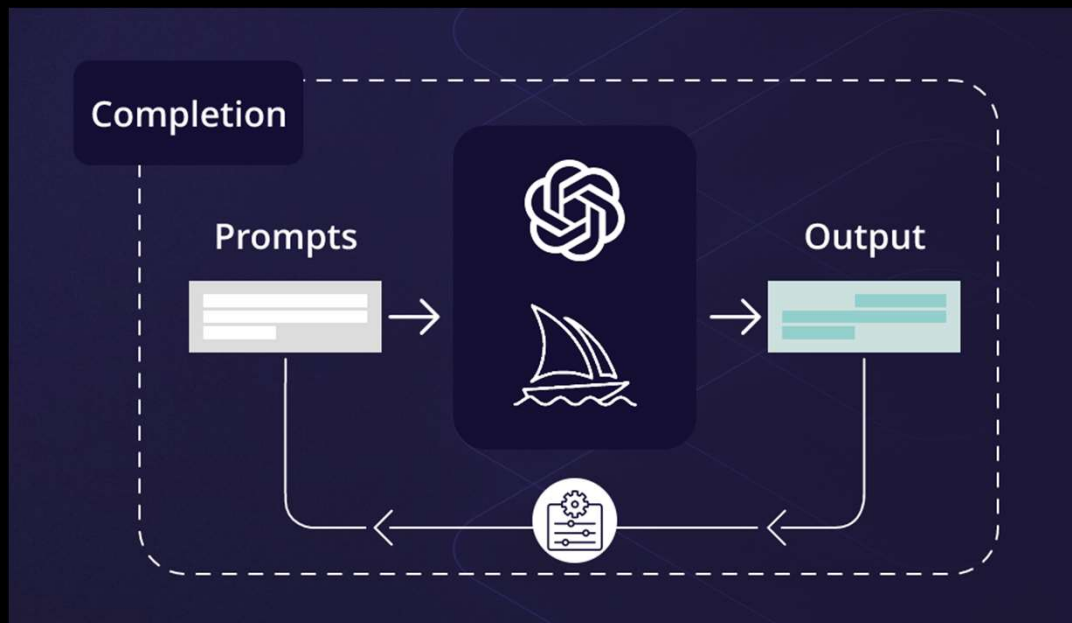

Prompt Engineering

A prompt guides the model to generate useful output.

Not satisfied with the output? Add more prompts...

Tip 1: Clarity

Ensure that the prompts are clear and unambiguous so that the user's intent can be accurately understood by the model.

Instead of:

I am interested in X, tell me about that.

Consider:

I am interested in X, including its history, features, and configuration

Tip 2: Relevance

Provide prompts that are relevant to the user's goals or interests, and avoid prompts that are unrelated or unhelpful.

Instead of:

What's a good book to read?

Consider:

What are some good books to read for someone who loves science fiction?

Tip 3: Diversity

Use a wide range of prompts that cover different topics, styles, and formats to improve the model's ability to generate diverse and high-quality responses.

Instead of:

Only using prompts that focus on mainstream culture or Western viewpoints.

Consider:

Including prompts that reflect a variety of cultures, languages, and experiences

Tip 4: Sensitivity

Avoid prompts that could be offensive or insensitive to certain groups of people, and use prompts that are inclusive and respectful to all users.

Instead of:

Using prompts that make assumptions about a user's gender, race, religion, or sexual orientation.

Consider:

Prompts that are more neutral and respectful, such as "What are some of your hobbies or interests?" or "What did you do over the weekend?"

Tip 5: Consistency

Use prompts that are consistent with the tone, style, and language of the user's previous messages to create a more natural and coherent conversation.

Instead of:

Instead of using prompts that are inconsistent with the user's previous messages,

Consider:

Use relevant and consistent prompts with the tone, style, and language of the user's previous messages.
